Project update – Key issues from Rome

Some key issues from our discussion of stakeholder requirements a year ago:

- More emphasis needed on establishing causal linkages between indicators and measures / programme
- Need for innovative approaches to define comparison groups in counterfactuals
- > Stronger focus on case study approaches
 - →better understanding of causalities and drivers of RDP impacts
 - →useful insights into specific regional impacts of RD measures and programs
 - →ENVIEVAL could deliver methods for case study applications in evaluations






Project update - Some key issues from Rome

- Impact assessment at micro level needs to provide the learning and evidence base for macro level assessments
- Methods are needed which can contribute to measuring netimpacts and attribute changes in indicators to measures and programmes
- > ENVIEVAL should provide the scientific basis for:
 - →Informing the selection of observations (type and scale)
 - →Selection of methods best suited to:
 - →the requirements of the reporting
 - →available data
 - →different aspirations and capacities in Member States
